## **AGBAY** Cake Leveler Blade Replacement Instructions

This blade is intended for use on **AGBAY** Levelers only.



- Removing Blade -

- 1. Cover blade with blade guard.
- 2. Remove both foot sub-assemblies from frame. (see fig.#1)
- \* **Double Blade Levelers:** Disassemble Upper Blade Frame from Lower Blade Frame by removing both back knobs before changing blades.
- 3. Remove tension from blade by loosening four socket head screws on both sides of tool. Loosen each screw with a 3/16 allen wrench (5/32 Allen wrench for Jrs.) four complete turns. (see fig.#2) It is now safe to remove the blade.
- 4. Using a screw driver, remove the two screws that secure the blade to the frame.

## • Installing Blade -

- 1. Make sure the four socket head cap screws on frame are loose (two screws on each side).
- 2. Place blade into blade guard, then using a screw driver, install the two screws through holes in blade and into threaded holes in bottom of frame.

**Important:** \* **Single Blade Levelers**: Cutting edge of blade must be on the same side as the rounded filler screw for .

- \* **Double Blade Levelers**: Cutting edge of blade must be on the opposite side of caution label on the Lower Frame but on the same side on the Upper Frame.
- 3. Tighten the four socket head screws. This will put the blade in tension.
- 4. Reinstall foot sub-assemblies so that scales are on the same side as caution label.
- \* **Double Blade Levelers:** Re-assemble Upper Blade Frame to Lower Blade Frame with back knobs making sure that both blades face the same direction.
